110 Tactical Emergency Casualty Care

The 2nd edition of NAEMT's Tactical Emergency Casualty Care (TECC) course teaches EMS practitioners and other prehospital providers how to respond to and care for patients in a civilian tactical environment. The course presents the three phases of tactical care and integrates parallel EMS nomenclature including Hot Zone/Direct Threat Care that is rendered while under attack or in adverse conditions, Warm Zone/Indirect Threat Care that is rendered while the threat has been suppressed but may resurface at any point and Cold Zone/Evacuation Care that is rendered while the casualty is being evacuated from the incident site.

Patient simulations are incorporated into the course and will cover the following topics:

- Hemorrhage control including immediate action drills for tourniquet application throughout the course;
- Complete coverage of the MARCH assessment;
- Surgical airway control and needle decompression;
- Strategies for treating wounded responders in threatening environments;
- Caring for pediatric patients;
- Techniques for dragging and carrying victims to safety; and
- A final, mass-casualty/active shooter event simulation.

Lunch will be available to purchase at the site of the training for \$6 per person per day. This course will be held off-site. This 2-day course will be offered Saturday-Sunday.
