301 Arson I – Fire Investigations for First Responders (National Fire Academy)

The purpose of this course is to provide first responders with the tools to understand the key role they play in fire scene examination and in preserving and protecting important evidence for any subsequent investigation. The content of the course will provide a clear definition of the role of the first responder and identify the preservation and protection of evidence and proper reporting of information to appropriate officials. By strengthening the partnership between first responders and investigators, the chances for successfully solving arson-related crimes will increase. This course exceeds the requirements of FIR 1035 in the KCTCS Fire Science Technology program.
