Re: Announcement of a Hazardous Materials Technician Class

We are planning to conduct a Hazardous Materials Technician Class in May 2010 at the Wendell H. Ford Regional Training Center. This will be a 40 hour class following the EPA 165.15 curriculum. Class participants will receive a certificate of completion at the end of the class from State Fire Rescue Training. Students may be eligible for receiving a certificate from EPA if they will bring a statement from their doctor that they have passed the medical surveillance and have clearance from their physician that they are able to wear a SCBA in a hazardous atmosphere in accordance with the OSHA standard 1910.134.

We will be utilizing the EPA's 165.15 – Emergency Response to Haz-mat Incidents curriculum. This is a 40-hour course and thus will be presented over 5 days from 8:00am until 5:00pm each day. There will be classroom lecture as well as hands-on activities in this class.
