



DRIVERS TRAINING SIMULATOR

Course Description:

The Kentucky Fire Commission, in an effort to reduce the number of deaths and injuries resulting from accidents involving Emergency Response vehicles, purchased a Mobile Driver Training Simulator. The trailer has three simulators stationed in the trailer along with the Instructor Operator Station. There are numerous scripts written and loaded in the simulator to allow for effective learning of safe operations of emergency vehicles. In the simulated driving course, there are obstacles that will challenge the EVO to instill 'Critical Thinking' into their driving processes. This course was developed by State Fire Rescue Training.
