116 Small Unmanned Aircraft Systems (Drones)

This course prepares firefighters and emergency responders to safely operate Small Unmanned Aircraft Systems during public safety missions. Participants will receive instruction in aircraft components, flight operations, mission planning, emergency procedures, and practical scenario-based applications such as fireground support, search and rescue, and damage assessment. Drones will be provided by SFRT for those attending. Participants may only bring Fire Department owned, FAA registered, and Fire Department insured drones. **No personally owned drones are allowed.**

PRE-REQUISITES/EQUIPMENT NEEDED

Participants must possess a valid FAA Part 107 Remote Pilot Certificate **before** attending the course. Participants must email a copy of their FAA Part 107 Remote Pilot Certificate to area3@kctcs.edu.
